Cervical Cancer Screening in Norway: Optimizing the Management of Women with Minor Cervical Lesions under Alternative Analytic Assumptions



The Cancer Registry of Norway, responsible for managing the Norwegian Cervical Cancer Screening program, has recently updated their screening guidelines for the management of women with minor cervical lesions. Prior to implementation, Norwegian stakeholders requested a decision analysis using only short-term health outcomes. This seminar will present preliminary findings for the optimal management strategy using a natural history model of cervical cancer, comparing the implications of using different analytic assumptions (i.e., longer- versus shorter-term health outcomes) on the optimal strategy.
