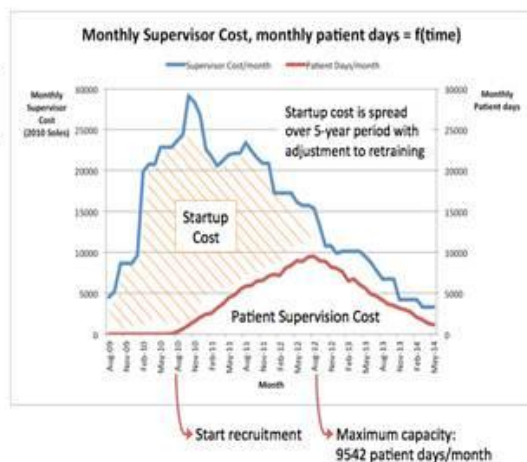

## ***The Cost (and Effectiveness) of DOT-HAART for HIV Patients in Lima, Peru***



HIV treatment efforts in resource-poor settings are now challenged by highly active antiretroviral treatment (HAART) nonadherence, associated with excess morbidity and mortality. This work in progress is evaluating the impact of Community-based daily observed treatment (DOT-HAART) to healthcare utilization and the cost (and effectiveness) of DOT-HAART for HIV patients in Lima, Peru.
