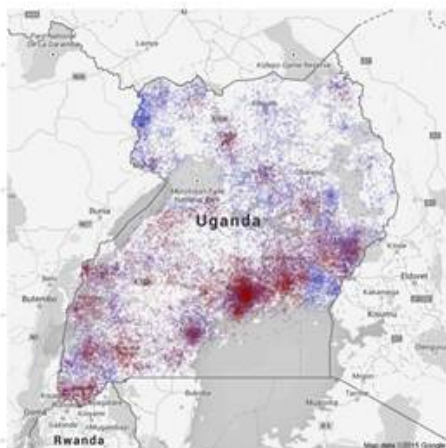

***Surgery, Poverty and Health in the US  
and Around the World***



The goal of this talk will be to examine the effects of policies and platforms for global surgical delivery on health, impoverishment, and inequity, and to determine how individuals value trade-offs among these outcomes. Three projects will be presented, which will 1) evaluate government policies to increase surgical access, 2) compare charitable surgical delivery platforms to these policies, and 3) construct a societal indifference curve for the trade-off between health and impoverishment.
