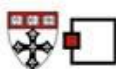

Craig White will discuss the findings of a recent microsimulation model to determine which of three protocols for active surveillance of low-risk prostate cancer is optimal. He'll also discuss some of the logistical challenges involved in determining the appropriate parameterization, and a couple of simple methods for optimizing model run time of a model written in TreeAge.
